Fresh apple fruits, floral and lemon citrus enriched with light ginger spices. Good wood maturity balanced with peat smoke and dried fruits.

PALATE

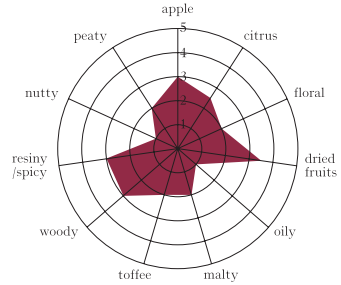
Apple, lemon citrus with hints of drying wood, warming and peaty.
