Hollywood released his musical 'Shall We Dance' the same year, starring Fred Astaire and Ginger Rogers and featuring the song 'Let's Call The Whole Thing Off'. In the UK, the steam locomotive, Mallard, sets a new world speed record for steam by reaching 125.88mph.

ORIGIN

Acquired in bottle from a private collection.

NOSE

Apple fruits with floral notes balanced with citrus orange and clear esters (pear drops). Hints of nuttiness adds complexity.

PALATE

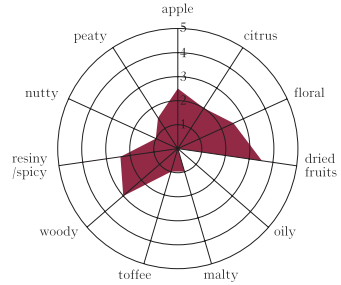
Light citrus fruits and spices balanced with peat reek (smoke), good dried fruits and aged wood.

FINISH

Fruits and wood with lingering peat smoke – rich, round, smooth and long. A little dryness is evident in this bottling.
