PALATE

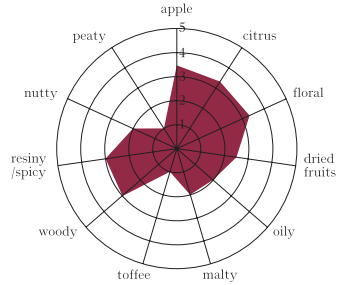
A rich mix of wood and peat, some dried fruits and clear orange.
